### WHAT TOPICS DOES THIS COURSE COVER?

This course provides practical guidance for building suitable and sustainable apprenticeship systems.

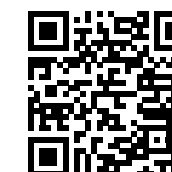
